As many of us have concerns about the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), we want to reassure you that the IUCC Early Childhood Center takes the health and safety of the children in our care very seriously. We always have and we always will. We are especially vigilant with the sanitation of our facility, regularly wiping down handles, furniture and other surfaces with disinfectant. We teach the children to cover their cough/sneeze in their elbows, to wipe their noses with tissue, and to wash their hands often.

In the effort to keep everyone safe and healthy, we ask that you take precautions at home as well. We encourage washing hands often with soap and water, and teaching your children to cover their coughs and sneezes with their elbows. Also, if your child is showing any signs of illness, please keep them home.
